GUIDELINES FOR MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS

2. Application for membership to the HBPRCA is complimentary. A person who is nominated and approved for membership at the Annual General Meeting is eligible to be an ordinary member of the Council on payment of the annual subscription fee. There is no annual subscription fee for student members.
3. Membership applications shall be made in writing (email) and must be accompanied by:
 - (a) the Curriculum Vitae of the nominee
 - (b) letters of support from two nominating current members
4. Student Membership is available to bona fide students.
5. Honorary Membership is available to members on their retirement from academic or clinical employment.
6. Honorary Life Membership can be proposed for outstanding contributors to the Council.
7. All benefits of membership will be made available to a membership applicant until a formal decision is made at the AGM.
