



## Research Exchange Grant Proposal

### Aim:

The aim of the research exchange grant is to encourage early career researchers to begin to advance international research collaborations and to spend time in a new lab (outside of Australia) to either work on a project or learn a new skill.

### Description:

Two grants of \$3000 to provide support for an international research exchange for a dedicated period (i.e. 4-6 weeks). The use of funds is not prescriptive, and they may be used to cover costs associated with travel, living expenses research/lab fees etc. All intended expenses must, however, be outlined in the budget section of the application, and a final budget to demonstrate how the funds were used to be provided at conclusion.

### Eligibility:

- Must be a current financial member of the HBPRCA
- Must have been a member of the HBPRCA for at least 2 years (student membership included)
- Must be no more than 5 years post-PhD
- Must have agreement from a supervisor that they will be available to supervise the exchange as outlined in this application

### Requirements:

- Fully completed application form
- Applicant CV (4 pages max)
- Requirement to write a report on the benefits of the exchange and to give a brief presentation at the AGM.
- Ongoing plans demonstrated to ensure longevity of benefit of international collaboration including shared research and ongoing projects and collaboration on papers

### Selection criteria for applicants:

Funding will be on a competitive basis with reference to strategic value, feasibility, researchers' record of achievement relative to opportunity and likelihood of meeting key outcomes specified in the application. The potential for ongoing collaboration will also be considered.

### Evaluation process

- Proposal due to HBPRCA secretariat ([admin@yoursecretariat.com.au](mailto:admin@yoursecretariat.com.au)) by 5pm, 15<sup>th</sup> April 2019. (Late applications will not be considered)
- Awarding in early May.
- Note, winners of awards at the recent ASM will not be eligible.
